

**Bloomington Park District  
Board of Commissioners Meeting  
October 6, 2008  
Johnston Recreation Center**

**Meeting - Called to Order**

The meeting of the Bloomington Park District Board of Commissioners was called to order at 7:38 pm. In attendance were Commissioners Mike Vogl, Lori Noonan, Susan Lancaster and Karen Johns, Staff Members Carrie Hauptert, Ed Reidy, Anita Escalante and Andrea Pindak.

**Old Business**

**JRC Condition** – Specialty Floors, Inc. is working on the replacement of our gym floor which was completely destroyed as a result of the recent flooding. A suggestion was made to recycle some of the old gym floor and use it in the community room. The quote to do this came in at \$15,000 and was determined cost prohibitive.

**Springfield Park North** – A recent development was brought to light by the Village of Bloomington concerning storm water drainage at the construction site. Staff is working with the village to make sure that we are in full compliance with a new village ordinance (dated August 1, 2008) concerning storm water retention issues. The disc golf area has to be moved to at least 50 yards from the wetlands. After we confirm that the development is located far enough from the wetlands buffer, we will receive the proper permits from the village to continue with the project.

Staff recently met with the Chateau Lorraine homeowners association to review our progress at Springfield Park and the wetlands restoration project. This visit went well.

**Lakeview Park Improvements** – Staff continues to meet with Brusseau Design Group on a regular basis concerning plans for Lakeview Park. Staff will advise the board on October 27<sup>th</sup> the estimated cost to rebid this project. The board would also like to review our contract with Brusseau Design Group at this time.

**Park Maintenance** – A mowing contract has been signed for the next 6 weeks to allow our maintenance staff the availability to complete other projects. Maintenance staff will begin work on painting the Oasis pool and other important jobs.

**Adjournment**

Commissioner Johns moved, seconded by Commissioner Noonan, to adjourn the meeting at 8:23 pm. On voice vote the motion was approved 4-0.
