Sunrise/Sunset Extended Care

Extended Care is a great option for working parents, or kids who just can't get enough of camp! There are plenty of things to keep busy with including coloring, arts and crafts, board games and a variety of active sports. A snack is provided in the pm session. Camp counselors staff this program and escort children to and from Extended Care and campsites. Children must be pre-registered and purchase a punch card prior to attending. Punch cards are on an automatic charge system. You will need to provide a credit card number (no debit cards) and your card will be charged each time your available punches run out. Unused punches will be credited to your household account at the end of the summer, providing there are no pending fees associated with your account.

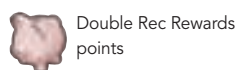
