Please complete a "Request for Public Records" available at the front office at 172 S. Circle Avenue, Bloomingdale. All requests will be fulfilled or responded to within five business days. There is no cost to inspect files or for the first 50 pages. There is a per sheet copy charge of .15 per page after the first 50 pages.

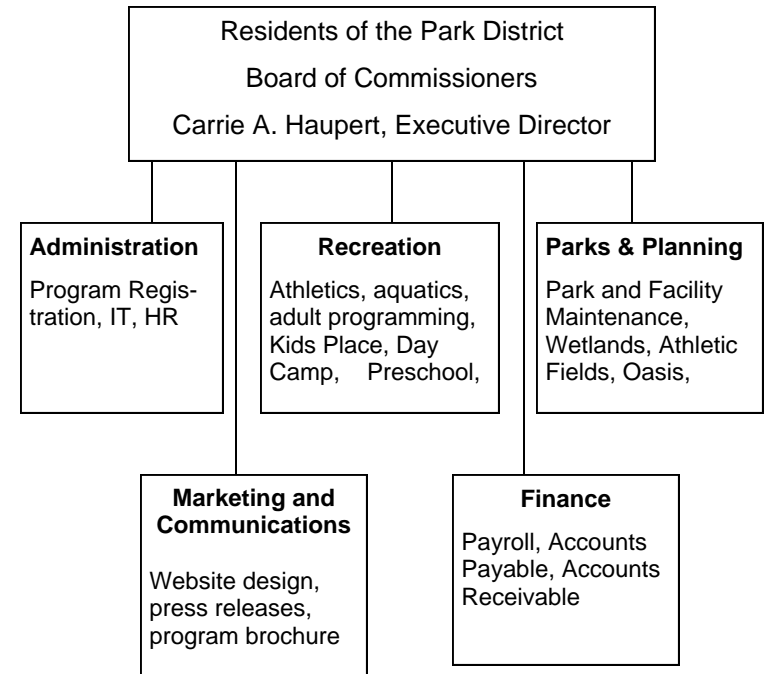
