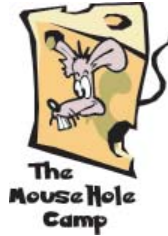

Junior Lifeguard Camp

Camp is directed by certified Oasis Water Park staff. Campers experience “hands-on” training and drills while testing their skills in various scenarios.

- Front crawl 25 yards continuously, with breathing
- Breast stroke 25 yards using a pull, breath, kick and glide sequence
- Tread water for one minute using arms and legs
- Show a level of comfort on the back by floating on the back for 30 seconds or swimming on the back for 25 yards using the elementary backstroke or back crawl
- Submerge and swim a distance of 10 feet under water
