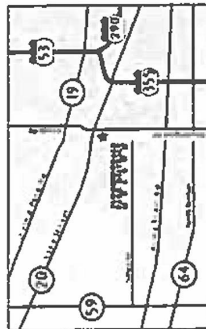

## *First Impressions*

Work entered in this show may be concerned with subjects and ideas not readily recognized by the casual observer.

## *Eligibility*

Open to any artist 18 and over. Traditional and non-traditional pieces in a variety of media are eligible. A limit of three pieces per artist may be submitted. We will only accept work that has been completed in the last three years and has not previously been on display at the Museum. No work that requires special installation is eligible. No nudity or any pieces deemed controversial or inappropriate by the curators will be allowed entry. **Note:** All work must be properly framed and wired. Wires must be taut and secure at a point at least 1/3 down the frame. No saw-tooth hangers. Wrapped edges must be finished.

## *Entry Fees*

There is a non-refundable fee of \$10 each or 3/\$25 payable by cash or check (made out to the Bloomingdale Park District) A maximum of three pieces may be submitted.

## *Juror*

Marcia Babler is an educator and a fine art artist. A Ragdale Foundation Residency Fellow, she was juried into the Illinois Arts Council's Arts-In-Education Roster. Her work has been in numerous one-woman and group exhibits including Northwestern University, Concordia University, Rockford Art Museum and The Alexandria Museum of Art, receiving national and regional awards. Current exhibits include the Dubuque Museum of Art Biennial and the upcoming North American Print Biennial in Boston. Her background includes technical fine art consultant for Grumbacher/Prismacolor, training developer for Blick Art Supplies and Columbia College professor. Her work is in corporate, university and private

You will be notified by e-mail or phone on Thursday, August 11 to pick up any pieces that are not accepted by the juror. The pick-up date for these pieces is Saturday, August 12 from 10am-2pm.

## *Sales*

The Bloomingdale Park District Museum retains a 30 percent commission on all works sold. Payment to the artist is made after the close of the exhibition.

## *Agreement*

By submitting this entry, the artist agrees to the conditions of this prospectus and agrees to the use of images for publicity.

## *Return of Entries*

The exhibition closes on Saturday, September 23 at 4 p.m. Artists must pick up their work either on Saturday September 23 between 4 and 6 p.m., or Monday, September 25 between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. Other arrangements may be made by calling the Museum.

## *Liability & Insurance*

The Bloomingdale Park District will NOT assume responsibility for any damages or loss for any exhibitor's property. All possible care is taken to safeguard works of art. The exhibitor's signature on the prospectus constitutes an agreement to the conditions contained in this prospectus. Failure to accept these conditions results in disqualification from the exhibit. All artists are responsible for carrying their own insurance on their work.

## *Note*

Work must remain for the entire duration of the show. NO early pick-up. Work left 14 days beyond the first pick-up date are considered property of the Museum unless specific arrangements are made.
